

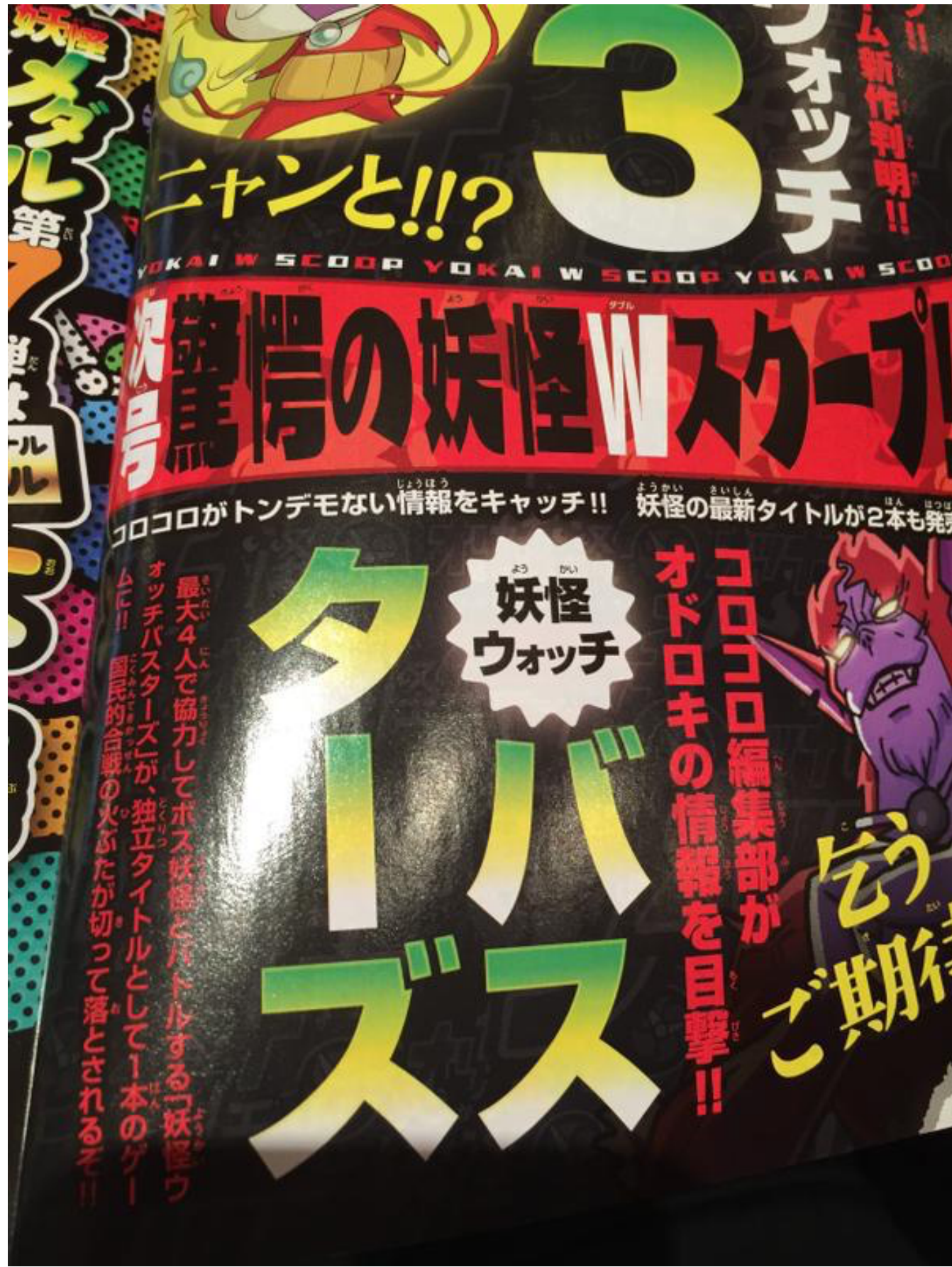
Yo-Kai Watch 3 and Yo-Kai Watch Busters Being Developed
